Geopoetics mini-festival

For PAW 2026, Burngate Purbeck Stone Centre, with the support of the Scottish Centre for Geopoetics and Purbeck Sounds Radio, brings together a series of events in Purbeck in celebration of geopoetics.

Geopoetics is a movement and a practice — a way of thinking, creating and living in direct relation with the Earth. Rooted in the work of poet and philosopher Kenneth White, it invites us to cross borders of art, science and culture to recover a more vivid, grounded sense of being in the world. To engage in geopoetics is to walk, to listen, to create — through word, image, sound, movement or form — in conversation with wind, stone and wave. It is a path of attention and imagination, cultivating what White called an Open World: a spacious awareness where creativity and knowledge, intellect and landscape, return once again to a radical field.

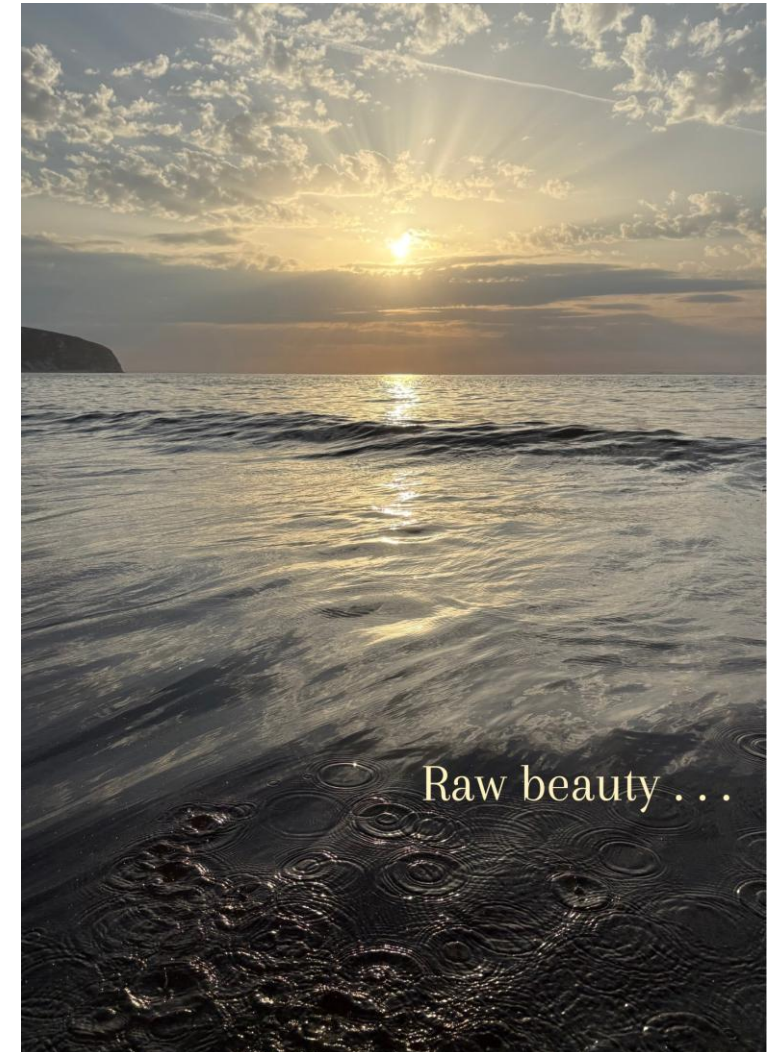

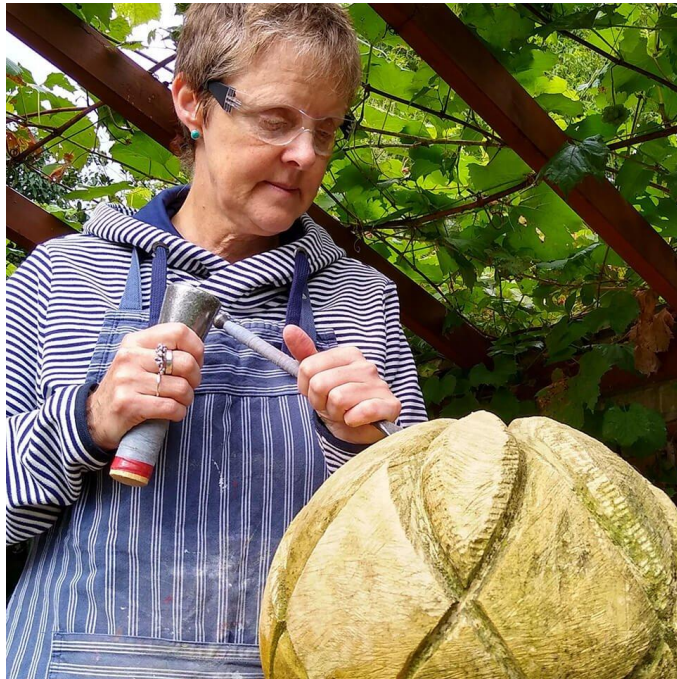

Two hours of poetry and fun at the Square and Compass where rocks and entertainment meet in good company.

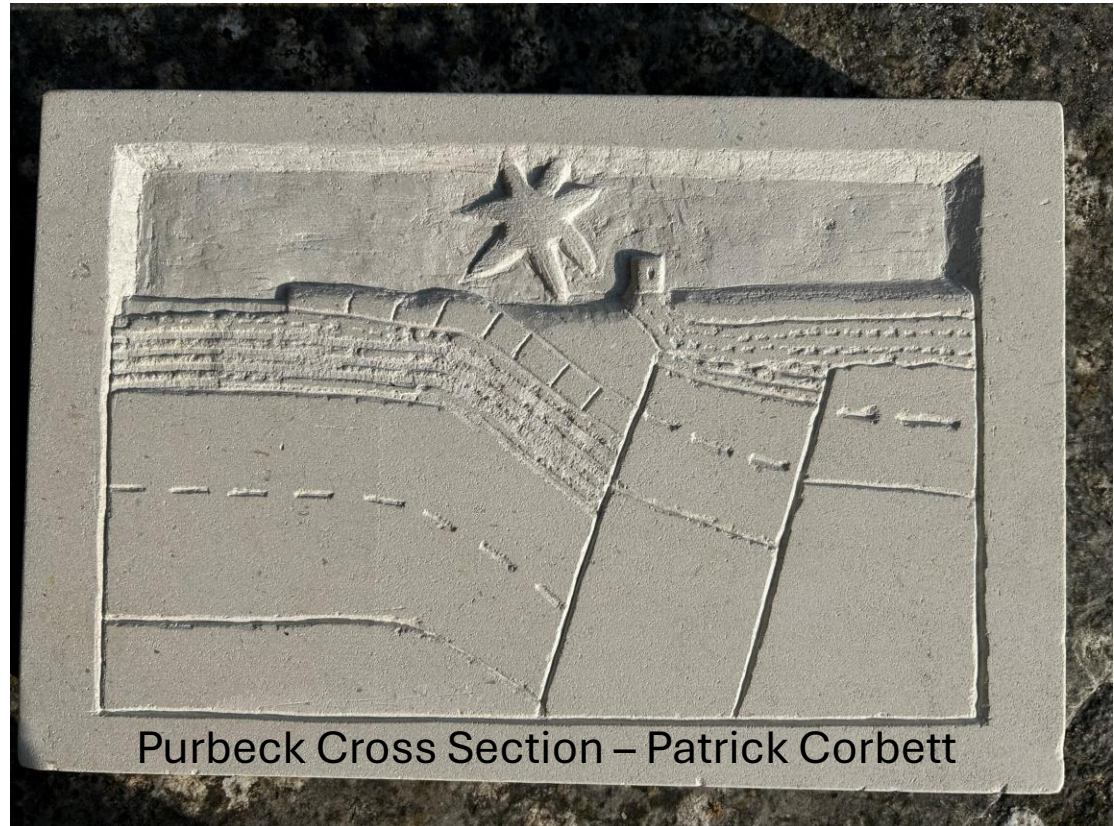


Amanda Randall – 2D stone carving – 30-31st May

Steve will talk about the main stones of the UK and their use for traditional letter-writing (featuring the Purbeck/Portland Stones)

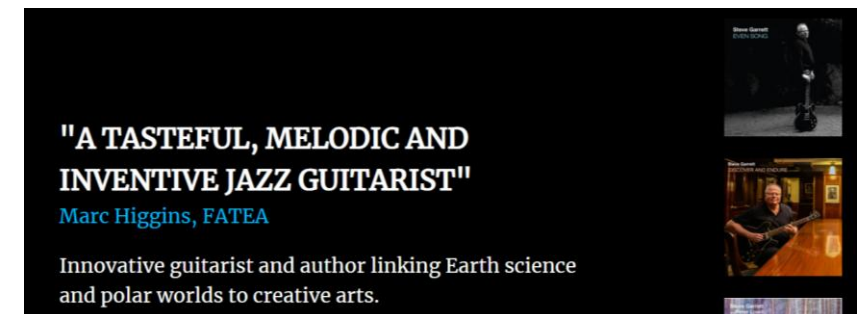
- *Music of Place* @ Square and Compass, Guitar

Expressing the Earth – Thursday 4th June

- 19:00 – 21:30 Worth Matravers Village Hall

The film was crowdfunded by the Scottish Centre for Geopoetics based on the Isle of Luing in Argyll and was sponsored by RSK environmental consultancy, the Geological Association and Edinburgh Geological Society. It explores geopoetics as the creative expression of the Earth through the eyes of painters, geologists, a slate mosaic sculptor, a dancer/choreographer, a musician/composer and an island author in stunning locations on the west and east coasts of Scotland. In doing so its beautiful cinematography also reveals the captivating poetry of the Scottish writer and thinker Kenneth White who was born in Glasgow, grew up in Fairlie in Ayrshire and lived much of his life in France.
